
To All Vermont Medicaid EHR Incentive Program participants:

**MODIFIED MEANINGFUL USE STAGE 2 NOW IN EFFECT; A/I/U APPLICATIONS MAY CONTINUE TO BE SUBMITTED**

Modified-MU2 is now in effect, and providers participating in the VT Medicaid EHRIP will **NOT** be able to submit Program Year 2015 attestations for *Meaningful Use* until MAPIR is upgraded to accommodate the new rule. Providers **CAN** continue to attest to *Adopt, Implement, or Upgrade* (AIU) in the MAPIR system, for their first year participating in the EHR Incentive program. All MU applications must wait to be submitted when MAPIR is able to accept the Modified-MU2 Objectives, which is scheduled to be available by the end of March 2016 for Vermont Medicaid EHR Incentive Program participants. In the meantime, any applications for Meaningful Use that were not submitted by midnight 12/14/15, or that are inadvertently started before we announce the deployment of the MAPIR upgrade, will be aborted.
