What is VHIE Data Governance?

Definition

 Includes the people, processes, and technologies needed to manage and protect data assets in order to guarantee generally understandable, correct, complete, trustworthy, secure, accessible, and usable data



For VITL

- Policies and procedures for governing data within the VHIE
 - Stewardship, storage, standards, formats, use, security, retention, transmission, and dissemination



Why Implement Data Governance?

- Data is an asset
- Asset management is important
 - Know what you have
 - Improve use and ensure efficiency
 - Maintain compliance
 - Identify and manage risks
- Data governance is data asset management





Why Implement Data Governance?

- 2019 DVHA/ADS Business Domain Assessment
 - Recommendation to formalize the process
- CY20 contract section 5.7
 - Four quarterly deliverables
 - Ultimately drives creation of an initial implementation plan for CY21
- Initial implementation intended to be in CY21 contract





Why Implement Data Governance?

Definition:

 Includes the people, processes, and technologies needed to manage and protect data assets in order to guarantee generally understandable, correct, complete, trustworthy, secure, accessible, and usable data

- Aims to ensure VHIE data is
 - Understandable
 - Correct, complete, trustworthy
 - Accessible and usable
 - Secure



How are we Implementing?

- Already completed
 - Identified internal and external roles
 - Defined internal role responsibilities
 - Specified data governance model
 - Listed data governance groups and their hierarchy
 - Identified required documentation





How are we Implementing?


- CY21
 - Scope near-term implementation
 - Complete required documentation
 - Write data governance policy
 - Complete VHIE data dictionary
 - Apply policies
- Beyond
 - Continue to assess scope








Updates

HIE Plan

- The final draft is in included in the meeting invite
- The Plan will be submitted to the GMCB on October 30 and presented on November 18
- The Protocols for Sharing Data on the VHIE now:
 - Represents how the VHIE aids VDH in accomplishing their work as a Public Health Authority as directed by state and federal law
 - Underscores that VDH may access PHI from the VHIE in response to a Significant Public Health Risk (defined by state law)
