I.	Welcome	Hahr	Hahr welcomed the group to the seventeenth meeting and welcomed Emily back from maternity leave. In addition, Hahr announced that 2019-2020 HIE Plan Update was submitted to the Green Mountain Care Board (GMCB) on November 1, 2019. This was the first annual update to the initial 2018-2019 HIE Strategic Plan.	
II.	HIE Strategic Plan	Samuelson	Samuelson reviewed the highlights of the HIE Plan Update (see presentation here) and also announced that the updated Plan is to be presented to the GMCB following this Steering Committee Meeting. The legislature requires the Plan be updated to the GMCB every year, with a major overhaul taking place every five years. This Plan builds on the work reflected in last year's approved Plan, noting the progress being made and identifies the upcoming work for 2020. The five key areas of the Plan include the following:  • Operations – includes the three overall HIE goals, progress of work detailed in the Tactical Plan and HIE Roadmap, aims at accountability through our work with VITL, and also includes advancing and creating new Interfaces (i.e., Connectivity Criteria)  • Finance – aims to continue support of sustainable financing through the CMS HITECH Advanced Planning Document • Governance – the HIE Steering Committee approved convening Sub- Committees to carry forth the work recommended in the HIE Technical Roadmap & Tactical Plan	

		<ul> <li>Consent Policy – overview, managing consent, and Evaluation Methodology</li> <li>Collaborative Services – which includes Data Quality, Identity Management, and cost savings</li> </ul>
		When presenting to the GMCB, the Committee suggested pairing known examples (i.e., use cases) to each of the five key areas above as to not lose them in the language and to drive home the point.
		In addition to the conversation above, the group reflected on their work with Lantana, the vendor chosen to help develop our HIE Technical Roadmap.
