Syndromic Surveillance Registry Reporting for Eligible Professionals

Public Health Objective Documentation Aid Program Year 2021, MU Stage 3: Objective 8 Option 2

- The Vermont Department of Health and the New Hampshire Department of Health and Human Services have not declared readiness to accept Syndromic Surveillance data from Eligible Professionals (EPs).
- EPs should **not** select *Yes* to Option 2, Syndromic Surveillance Reporting.
- All EPs must select *No* to Option 2.
- All EPs may select *Yes* to this exclusion: "Is not in a category of providers from which ambulatory syndromic surveillance data is collected by their jurisdiction's syndromic surveillance system."
- No documentation is required to be submitted for the exclusion to Syndromic Surveillance Reporting.

Please Note: The terms "EHR Reporting Period," "MU Reporting Period", and "Promoting Interoperability (PI) Reporting Period" all refer to the continuous 90-day period within the Program Year in which an Eligible Professional demonstrates meaningful use of certified EHR technology.
