

# **Social Determinants of Health Update**

#### Accomplishments

 Briljent submitted its final Data Governance Plan, and the State reviewed and accepted the deliverable. Briljent has also submitted a draft SDOH consent mechanism that is being reviewed.

#### Timeline

Work is on schedule to be completed in mid-2024.

#### **Timeline**


- Phase 2 Stakeholder engagement (April through July 2024) is in progress.

# Data Integration Team - Data Completeness Update on Measures



## VHIE Data Completeness Evaluation

- VITL will evaluate structured data in the VHIE relative to:
  - Hypertension and Blood Pressure readings
  - Diabetes and Hemoglobin A1C results
  - Depression Screening and positive and negative findings
- Patient cohorts and measures will be based on related Healthcare Effectiveness Data and Information Set (<u>HEDIS</u>)
  - Controlling High Blood Pressure
  - Hemoglobin A1C Control for Patients with Diabetes
  - Depression Screening for Adolescents and Adults
- VITL will evaluate completeness by comparing data contributed by all sources comprising the person's comprehensive record in the VHIE
- Data must be discretely reported using standardized vocabulary (SNOMED, LOINC, ICD-10, etc.)
- VITL will report data completeness evaluation results in monthly dashboards

## **Controlling Blood Pressure for Vermonters**

- Cohort: Vermonters aged 18 to 85
- Measure: Blood pressure in control
  - Systolic (<140 mmHg)</li>
  - Diastolic (<90 mmHg)</li>

#### Cohort Dashboards

- Percentage of the cohort with the presence of systolic/diastolic readings within the past 3 years
- Percentage of the cohort whose <u>last</u> systolic/diastolic readings within the past 3 years are in control
- Total count of systolic/diastolic readings for the cohort within the past 3 years

#### Cohort with Hypertension Dashboards

- Percentage of the cohort with a Hypertension diagnosis within past 3 years
- Percentage of the cohort with a Hypertension diagnosis whose <u>last</u> systolic and diastolic readings are in control

## Hemoglobin A1C Control for Vermonters

- Cohort: Vermonters aged 18 to 75
- Measure: Hemoglobin A1C results in control vs. poor control
  - Glycemic status in control: < 8%</li>
  - Glycemic status poor control: > 9%
  - Feedback cohort whose glycemic status is in the 8 to 9% range?

#### Cohort Dashboards

- Percentage of the cohort with a Hemoglobin A1C result within the past 3 years
- Total count of Hemoglobin A1C results for the cohort within the past 3 years
- Percentage of the cohort whose <u>last</u> Hemoglobin A1C glycemic status within the past 3 years is in control vs poor control

#### Cohort with Diabetes Dashboards

- Percentage of the cohort with a Diabetes diagnosis within the past 3 years
- Percentage of the cohort with a Diabetes diagnosis within the past 3 years whose <u>last</u>
   Hemoglobin A1C glycemic status is in control vs poor control

## Depression screening for Vermonters

- Cohort: Vermonters aged 12 and older
- Measure: Depression screening reported
  - Positive finding
  - Negative finding

#### Cohort Dashboards

- Percentage of cohort with a Depression screening performed within the last 3 years
- Total count of positive and negative Depression screening findings for the cohort within the past 3 years
- Percentage of the cohort whose <u>last</u> Depression screening finding was positive vs. negative within the past 3 years
