# The Vermont Health Information Exchange was Certified by CMS as part of Vermont's Medicaid Enterprise

- **Quick Facts:**

- CMS' "Outcomes Based Certification" is an opportunity newly extended to Health Information Exchanges (HIE) as systems that support Medicaid operations, Medicaid providers, and Medicaid beneficiaries
- Certification allows systems to receive ongoing funding for operations through a federal Medicaid funding stream (MMIS)
- We have been working towards VHIE Certification for close to 2 years
- Vermont is one of a handful of states that have reached this milestone - many more aim to certify HIE functionality and systems



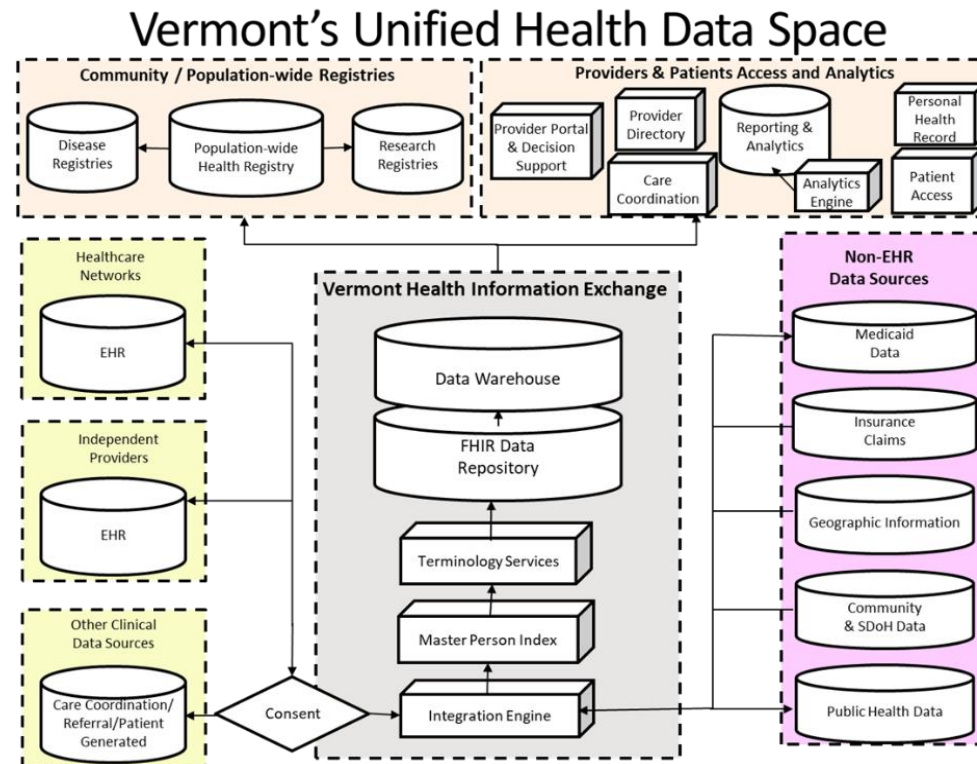

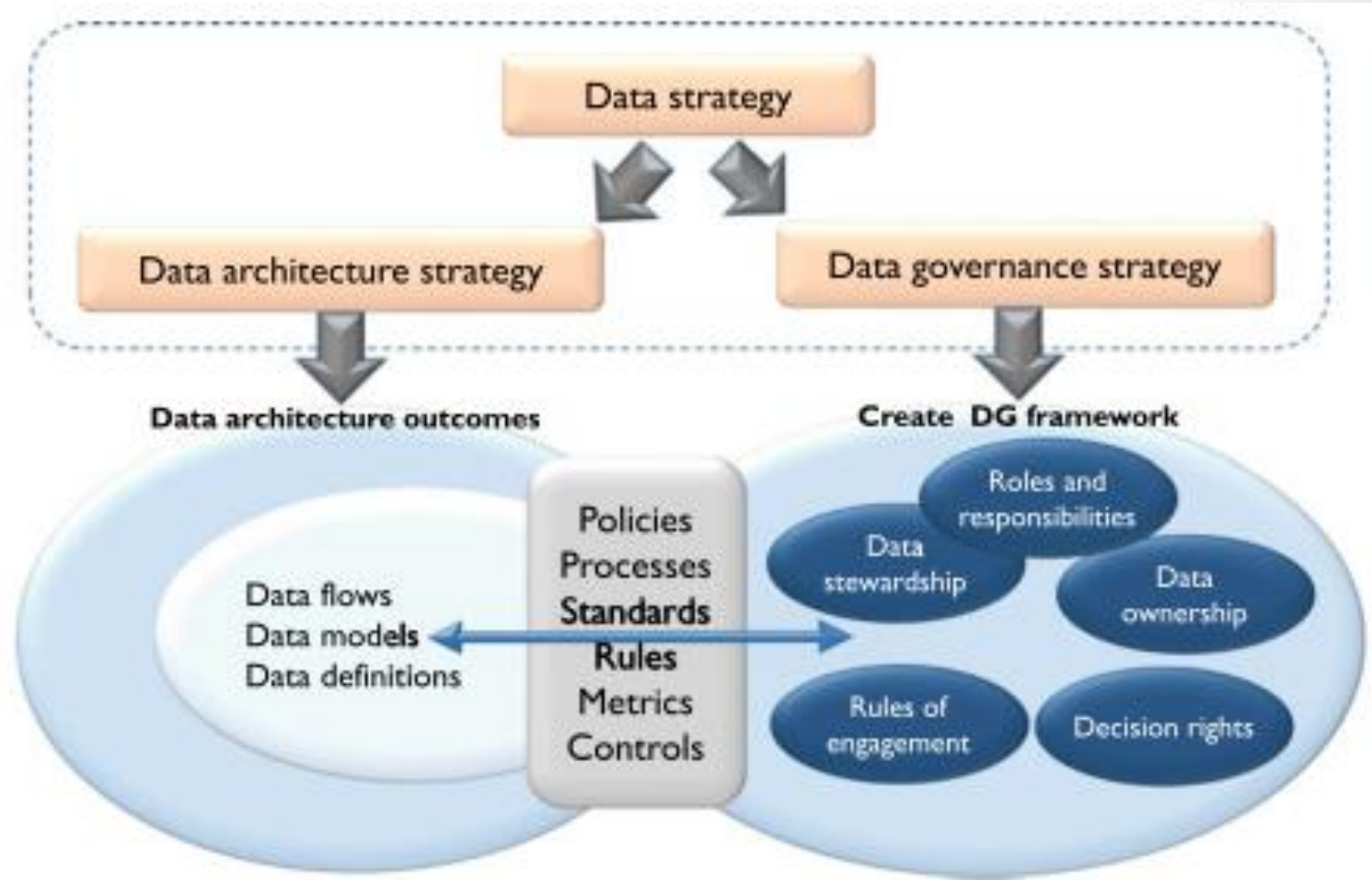

- Team of GMCB, AHS-CO and MDWAS project staff working to establish a consulting services contract to support the State in developing a Health Data Strategy & Governance Plan that illustrates clear governance models by which health data is stewarded and details behind why, when, and how data flows through the Unified Health Data Space

- Phase IV: Final Execution including MDWAS Data Governance

# **An Overview of the Medicaid Data Warehouse & Analytics Solution (MDWAS) Project**

# The Problem

The State of Vermont does not currently have a centralized data repository with robust reporting and analysis tools that contains all Medicaid-related claims and clinical data.



# The Medicaid & Data Warehouse & Analytics Solution

- Integrate a new Medicaid Data Lake (MDL) and Data Analytics and Reporting (DAR) solution with the State's existing data warehouse operated by Vermont Information Technology Leaders (VITL).
- Enhancing the data warehouse will allow the State to reuse existing technology with a focus on extensibility, allowing stakeholders to analyze and report on Medicaid data from a single location.
- The MDWAS project will achieve this through two concurrent workstreams.
  - Medicaid Data Lake & Analytics Solution (MDLAS)
  - Analytics Data Warehouse (ADW)



# One Project, Two Workstreams

## Medicaid Data Lake & Analytics Solution (MDLAS)

- The MDL will ingest data from various data sources across the Medicaid Enterprise System, store the data and make it available for the ADW.
- The DAR solution will be the primary Business Intelligence (BI) platform for stakeholders to access and use aggregated patient health data to perform reporting and data analytics.

## Analytics Data Warehouse (ADW)

- Modify and integrate the State's existing data warehouse with the new MDL and DAR solutions.
- The ADW will ingest data from the MDL and existing healthcare provider data sources, store it, and make it available to the DAR.
- The ADW will include a new sandbox platform that will enable data scientists to query and analyze deidentified Medicaid data sets from within the ADW.

# VHIE/VDH Integration Strategy

*“Improving Public Health Capabilities through Integration with the VHIE – To fully participate in the vision of a Unified Health Data Space, public health data and systems must be integrated with the VHIE. In 2022, AHS will partner with VITL to design a strategy for bolstering public health management through partnership with the VHIE. The integration strategy will consider leveraging VHIE infrastructure to enhance public health operations (an effort to reuse existing technical capabilities), incorporating public health data (e.g., immunizations, birth/death, cancer records) into the health record contained on the VHIE, and reporting for public health surveillance and monitoring. The strategy will build on lessons learned from the COVID-19 response and account for new federal requirements for state-level reporting. The HIE Steering Committee will provide feedback on the public health data strategy and use it to inform ongoing efforts to propel state-wide health information exchange.”*

# VHIE/VDH Integration Strategy

- VDH and DVHA secured a [COVID-19 Immunization Data Exchange, Advancement & Sharing \(IDEAS\) Grant](#)
  - ASTHO, in partnership with the Office of the National Coordinator
- The IDEAS grant funds be used to procure a consultant to support the State is developing the Vermont Department of Health and HIE Integration Strategy AND cover some technical development costs.
  - MMIS funding approved to support VITL's work developing bi-directional data exchange with Vermont's Immunization Registry
- IDEAS grant timing: ~May 2022 – September 2023
