# WHEN TO APPLY FOR PROGRAM YEAR 2016

Program Year 2016 EHRIP applications are now being accepted, but your ability to proceed in the MAPIR attestation system will depend upon your progress to date. CMS recently ruled that the 90-day EHR Reporting Period for providers demonstrating Meaningful Use will be applicable to Program Year 2016 and Program Year 2017. Modifications to MAPIR will be completed in early January to accommodate the change to the EHR Reporting Period. If you are submitting an application for the first time in Program Year 2016, either for Adopt/Implement/Upgrade or for meeting Meaningful Use, you are able to proceed now. If you are a returning provider applying for a second-year payment and demonstrating Meaningful Use, you may also proceed now with your applications. However, if you are in Payment Year 3 or higher, you must wait to start a Program Year 2016 application until 1/12/16. Any such applications started before then must be aborted and re-started on or after that date. **PLEASE NOTE: The MAPIR system will not be available to start any applications between 1/1/17 - 1/11/17.**

# NEW QUALITY PROGRAM INITIATIVES: MACRA/MIPS

The U.S. Department of Health and Human Services recently finalized its policy implementing the Merit-Based Incentive Payment System (MIPS) and the Advanced Alternative Payment Model (APM) incentive payment provisions in the Medicare Access and CHIP Reauthorization Act of 2015 (MACRA). These initiatives are collectively referred to as the 'Quality Payment Program.'

## What does MIPS mean for the Medicaid EHR Incentive Program?

MIPS applies to physicians and clinicians providing services under Medicare Part B. **MIPS does not replace the Medicaid EHR Incentive Program, which will continue through 2021.** Eligible providers participating in the Vermont Medicaid EHRIP will continue to attest to receive their maximum number (six) of yearly incentive payments. If those providers are also Medicare Part B clinicians, they may also participate in MIPS.

**Milestones and Deadlines**: The Quality Payment Program's first performance period opens on January 1, 2017 and closes December 31, 2017. Participation in MIPS can start as early as January 1, 2017 or as late as October 2, 2017. The first payment adjustments based on performance go into effect on January 1, 2019.

## CHANGES TO SPECIFIC EHRIP OBJECTIVES FOR PY2016

- **Objective 9, Secure Messaging**: During payment year 2015 it was required that EHR Secure Messaging be "Fully Enabled" to indicate the use of secure messaging to communicate with patients on relevant health information. In MAPIR, the Objective was configured to be a "Yes/No" response. The requirement has changed for 2016 applications as indicated by CMS: In order to pass this measure, at least one patient-initiated message with provider response is now required. The action for the numerator must occur within the calendar year but may occur before, during or after the EHR reporting period if that period is less than one full calendar year. In MAPIR, Objective 9 now requires a numerator and denominator.
- **Objective 10, Public Health Reporting**: In Program Year 2015, EPs that were scheduled to meet Stage 1 MU were required to meet only one measure. For Program Year 2016, all EPs must meet **two measures**.
- Alternate Exclusions: Many of the Alternate exclusions ("*did not intend to report*") that were available in 2015 are not applicable in 2016. Review this <u>fact sheet</u> for an overview and more details about alternate exclusions for certain objectives and measures in 2016.

The CMS "<u>What You Need to Know for 2016</u>" tip sheet has additional guidance for EPs participating in Program Year 2016.
