## **UPDATES TO PUBLIC HEALTH REPORTING GUIDANCE FOR MU3 IN PY2019** (Updated 04/30/19)

## **CLINICAL QUALITY MEASURES FOR PY2019**

All Clinical Quality Measures in the PIP/EHR Incentive Program are referred to as "eCQMS" because they must be generated by a provider's Certified Electronic Health Record system. Eligible Professionals are not required to submit CQMs electronically in the **Medicaid** PIP/EHRIP. For Program Year 2019, EPs must submit data for six eCQMs relevant to their scope of practice. At least one of the eCQMs they select must be an outcome measure, if any are relevant. If no outcome measures are relevant, they must select at least one other high priority measure. If no high priority measures are relevant, they may report on any six relevant eCQMs. This table lists the 50 eCQMs that are available for EPs in the Medicaid PI Program for Program Year 2019, with the high priority and outcome measures highlighted:
