AUDIT GUIDANCE UPDATES

Audits of incentive payments are a required element of the PIP/EHR Incentive Program. Providers who receive a PIP/EHR incentive payment for the Medicaid PIP/EHR Incentive Program potentially may be subject to an audit. The Vermont Medicaid PIP/EHRIP Audit Team has developed helpful Eligible Professional Audit Tip Sheets based on their activities and experience with reviewing provider records. CMS UPDATES FOR eCQM REPORTING FOR PY2019

The <u>CMS Promoting Interoperability website</u> posted updates for Clinical Quality Measure reporting for Program Year 2019:

The 2019 eCQM reporting period for those who report electronically or through attestation is the full 2019 CY data. For EPs attesting for the first time, the 2019 reporting period for those who report electronically or through attestation is any continuous 90-day period within CY 2019. All participating EPs are required to report on any 6 eCQMs relevant to their scope of practice from the set of 50 available. In addition, EPs must report on at least one outcome measure. If no outcome measure is relevant to his or her scope of practice, the EP must report on one high priority measures. If no high priority measures are relevant to their scope of practice, they may report on any six relevant measures.
