To All Vermont Medicaid Promoting Interoperability/EHR Incentive Program participants:

PROGRAM YEAR 2019 APPLICATION SUBMISSIONS: JANUARY 2nd - FEBRUARY 29th, 2020

MAPIR will available to accept Program Year 2019 PIP/EHRIP applications as of January 2, 2020, and the deadline to submit will be February 29th, 2020.

WHAT IF A PROVIDER WILL NOT BE PARTICIPATING IN THE PIP FOR A PY2019 INCENTIVE?

Many practices are upgrading their EHR systems to 2015 Edition CEHRT, or switching EHR system vendors, and will not have a full 90 days of Promoting Interoperability Program data to report for 2019. Other providers have found that the Stage 3 Objectives and Measures are more challenging to meet as they continue to adjust their clinical workflows to meet their EHR vendor processes. If a provider will **not** be submitting an application for PY2019, there are **no penalties** for Medicaid providers who cannot meet Stage 3 Meaningful Use. They may simply skip a year and resume participation when they are able. However, if providers are subject to **Medicare** Quality Payment Program requirements, they will need to confirm that they are not subject to **Medicare payment adjustments** if they will not be able to meet those reporting obligations: https://qpp.cms.gov/mips/exception-applications.

PROGRAM YEAR 2019 SRA: CONDUCT OR REVIEW BY 12/31/19

All providers applying for a Promoting Interoperability/EHR Incentive Program payment must submit a Security Risk Analysis along with their application. The SRA must be conducted **or reviewed** for each Program Year an Eligible Provider applies for a PIP/EHR Incentive Program payment. It is acceptable for the SRA to be conducted or reviewed outside the 90-Day PIP/EHR reporting period; however, the SRA or review:

- Must be unique for each PIP/EHR reporting period;
- The scope must include the full PIP/EHR reporting period, and;
- Must be conducted within the calendar year of the PIP/EHR reporting period: January 1st –
 December 31st.

Please ensure all documentation submitted to support a PIP/EHRIP attestation contains **DATES** when the SRA was conducted or reviewed. More information about SRA requirements can be found at our website: https://healthdata.vermont.gov/ehrip/SRA
